ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM TROOP MEETING OF Monday, August 11, 2008

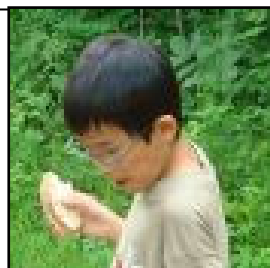
- **2-3 Scouts are needed for PROP service project on the 18th**
