Geocaching Gear

(heated cabin sleeping ***)

Clothing

- Scout Uniform with Neckerchief (wear while traveling)
- Snow-pants or snowmobile suit or really warm pants
- Thermal Tops (“Long Underwear”) (2) (synthetic, not cotton)
- Thermal Bottoms (2) (synthetic, not cotton)
- Winter-weight Jacket
- Snow Boots with Liners plus traveling shoes/boots (extra liners if you have them)
- Stocking Hat(s) & Facemasks or balaclava
- Mittens & Gloves (2 pair)
- Underwear (1-2 extra pair)
- Socks (3 pair thermal plus 2 pair liner socks)
- Fleece pants or sweatpants for extra layer while sleeping
- Fleece top or sweatshirt for extra layer while sleeping

Gear

- Compass
- Sleeping Bag
- Knife, Fork, Spoon
- Plate, Bowl, Cup
- Scout Handbook (notebook, pencil/pen)
- Sunglasses (the snow glare can be harsh)

- Patrol Box
- Patrol Food (with enough to feed two adult guests at each meal)

No Electronics

*** If you decide to sleep in a tent ***

- Your warmest sleeping bag
- Thermal sleeping pad
- Tent
- Fleece pants or sweatpants for extra layer while sleeping
- Fleece top or sweatshirt for extra layer while sleeping
