

Camp Onomia/Okpik Gear

Clothing

- Scout Uniform with Neckerchief (wear while traveling)
- Snow-pants or snowmobile suit
- Thermal Tops (“Long Underwear”) (2) (synthetic, not cotton)
- Thermal Bottoms (2) (synthetic, not cotton)
- Winter-weight Jacket
- Snow Boots with Liners plus traveling shoes/boots (extra liners if you have them)
- Stocking Hat(s) & Facemasks or balaclava
- Mittens & Gloves (2 pair)
- Underwear (1-2 extra pair)
- Socks (3 pair thermal plus 2 pair liner socks)
- Fleece pants or sweatpants for extra layer while sleeping
- Fleece top or sweatshirt for extra layer while sleeping

Gear

- Snow Shovel and garden trowel to dig with – if you have them
- Sleeping Bag (the warmest you have, you may add some blankets or put a lighter weight bag inside another to get to winter-weight)
- Sleeping Pad (closed-cell foam is preferred, Therma-rests also work, 2 pads are best)
- Knife, Fork, Spoon
- Plate, Bowl, Cup
- Scout Handbook (notebook, pencil/pen)
- Sunglasses (the snow glare can be harsh)

- Patrol Box
- Patrol Food

Troop will provide

- Tarps/plastic sheets for snow huts
- Duct tape
- Hand warmers
- High calorie campfire snacks for Saturday night
