

## PERSONAL CAMPING GEAR LIST FOR MANY POINT

- Backpack/bag for your gear
- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping pad
- Scout handbook
- Pen, pencil, notebook
- Flashlight & batteries
- Pocketknife & stone
- Bowl, cup, spoon
- Plate and fork
- Toothbrush & paste
- Soap, washcloth, hand towel
- Sunscreen
- Non-aerosol Bug repellent
- Water bottle
- Hat
- Hiking shoes
- Camp shoes
- Daypack
- Wallet with ID and money \*
- Clothing for 6 days: \*\*
  - Wear uniform
  - Raincoat with hood
  - Swimsuit – wear under uniform
  - 4+ underwear
  - 6 socks
  - 2+ short pants
  - 1+ long pants
  - 3 t-shirts – appropriate graphics
  - 1 fleece sweater
  - sleepwear
- Optional Items:
  - Bedsheet

- **Do NOT Bring:**
  - Flipflops
  - Electronic games
  - Music players
  - Fireworks
  - Anything you can't lose

**Mosquitos are BAD this year.** A bugscreen hat or suit should be considered. A light long-sleeve shirt and loose nylon long pants are helpful. I use a 25% DEET bug spray, such as Deepwoods OFF and it works for me.

\* - I feel sending \$30-35 total with a scout is adequate. \$12 for lunch on the way up and back, \$10 for trading post junk, another \$10-15 for a souvenir and emergency needs. Extra \$30 for Leatherwork & Basketry merit badges. Extra \$15 for Rifleshooting merit badge. Extra \$4 for Woodcarving merit badge.

\*\* - some scouts may wear their favorite pants and shirt the whole week. Others may want something new each day.

\*\*\* - non-perishable items only. Do not send 50 pounds of candy with your scout – it takes up too much space and does not help the scout. Pop and other sugar items are available at the trading post.

\*\*\*\* - a scout is responsible for taking his own medications. I can keep the medicine so I know it is being used correctly, but I cannot give out doses. I need signed instructions from you on what to do with the medicine. I also need to know about personal kits for stings or whatever so the adults are aware of possible problems.
